TYPES OF GRANTS & ELIGIBILITY

I. Innovative Learning Grants

a. Individual Teacher Grants

Grants will be awarded to teachers in amounts ranging from \$250 to \$1000. All certificated personnel in the SJUSD are eligible to apply for the Teacher Grants. Proposals may be submitted by individual teachers, teams of teachers, or certificated district personnel.

b. Field Experience Grants

Grants are available to facilitate education field trips, ranging from \$250 - \$1,000. Field trips must relate to specific grade-level curricula and support one of the grant program's three areas of focus: Science, Technology, and the Arts. Costs of videoconferencing equipment required for virtual field trips are eligible under this category.

Student Skills (10 pts)	The applicant clearly describes a program that encourages specific improvement in student’s skill and attitudes towards the academic focus area.		
Learning Objectives (10 pts.)	The applicant provides specific learning objectives that are tied to academic content standards.		
Project Evaluation (10 pts)	The applicant provides a clear description of how they will measure the effectiveness of program activities.		
Overall Impressions (15 pts)	The project description provides a clear picture of an innovative program to support student learning and access to content knowledge specific to the identified program area.		
Program Replication (10 pts)	The program described could be easily adapted for use by other teachers and/or schools		
Budget (10 pts)	The application includes a complete budget that directly supports the proposed activities and established a base for future education activities that will not require ongoing financial support.
